EAST NEUSE RIVER PARKWAY

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The East Neuse River Parkway (ENRP) is a private street and is owned and maintained by Flowers Plantation Foundation, Inc.
2. The ENRP is for Flowers Plantation residents to have access on a private street to the east and west ends of Flowers Plantation.
3. The ENRP is not for the public to use as a thoroughfare to avoid NC 42.
4. The ENRP is not intended to be used for a short cut by the public to access Buffalo Road or Neuse River Parkway or for any other purpose.
5. Golf carts are prohibited on the pedestrian sidewalk along ENRP.
6. Golf carts are allowed on the ENRP but must be operated by a licensed driver, 16 years of older.
7. Golf carts must be street legal with operable lights, signals and mirrors.
8. Bicycles are allowed on the sidewalk along ENRP.
9. Skateboards, scooters, roller blades and other similar transportation devices are prohibited from operation on the ENRP, sidewalks, and walking trails.
10. Speed bumps, 6" in height, are installed on ENRP to control vehicular speed limit.
11. The posted speed limit is 15 mph on ENRP.
